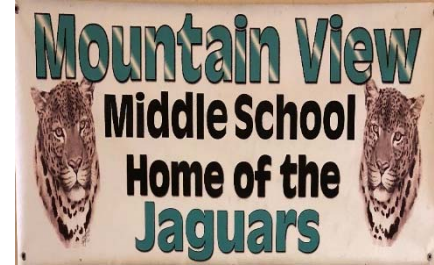

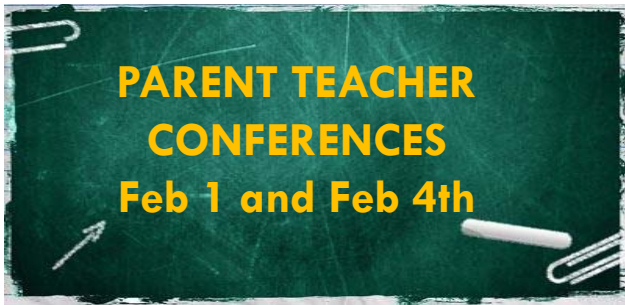

Governor Michelle Lujan Grisham has announced a move away from PARCC testing, summative standardized assessments are still a requirement. As such,

The 2019 Summative Math & ELA Transition Assessment ensures:

- Is aligned to the adopted New Mexico Common Core State Standards.
- Is 1 to 1.5 hours shorter per subject area, reducing overall testing time by 30%.
- Is not the same assessment as the old New Mexico SBA for Math and Reading from years past. The prior test was aligned to the former New Mexico Standards and Benchmarks.
- Has a new test blueprint and there are similarities in test design and structure in order to maintain comparability.
- Has the same accessibility features and accommodation options.

The comparability of this assessment to the former assessment means parents, educators, and public officials will be able to evaluate student growth and achievement with grade level learning standards.
